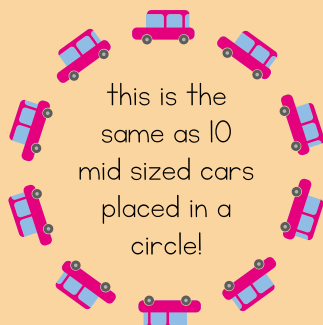
The tree with the biggest girth in the UK is a sweet chestnut in Wimborne in Dorset. Its waistline measures in at 14m.
